**WORK COMPLETED THIS WEEK:
MONDAY 08.17.2020 TO SATURDAY 08.22.2020**

Central Avenue

Major work this week included:

- Detour set in place on 8/17
- Watermain work between 10th Street and 7th Street
- Second watermain crew was added on Wednesday
- Temporary traffic signal posts installed at the intersection of Central and Wilmette

The construction team and School District 39 staff have been meeting regularly to coordinate the first day students will be returning to classrooms on September 8th. There will not be any construction activity within the school zone during school drop-off and pickup times.

MONDAY 08.24.2020 TO SATURDAY 08.29.2020**

- Electrical crews will install the temporary signals at the intersection of Central and Wilmette, as well as dismantling the old signal system to prepare for work in the downtown area set to start 8/31
- Watermain work will continue with two crews working in between 7th and Sheridan
- Water service transfers could start on Friday, 8/28. Those impacted will receive advanced notice from the construction team

If you are participating in the water sampling program and have not yet submitted your first sample, please do so as soon as possible.

DETOUR INFO

The detour for Central Avenue began on 8/17 - this means Central Avenue will be CLOSED to eastbound traffic between 11th Street and Sheridan Road. On 8/31 the detour will be extended to Green Bay Road until the project shuts down for the winter.
