**WORK COMPLETED THIS WEEK:
MONDAY 08.03.2020 TO FRIDAY 08.07.2020**

Central Avenue

You may have seen workers in construction vests up and down the street staking water service locations and applying paint for tree root pruning locations. Tree root pruning is a technique used to protect the integrity of the trees during construction. Tree root pruning will occur on Friday between 8th and 11th Street. Surveyors and electricians will also be on site Friday. This pre-construction work will not disrupt daily activities.

Central Avenue

Starting Monday, root pruning will continue and tree protection will be installed. This work will continue throughout the week. The contractor will also start cutting the pavement in anticipation for watermain installation. The watermain work will start at 10th Street and continue east. There will be material and equipment delivered to the site which may take up a few parking spaces between 11th and 10th Streets.

Starting Tuesday, watermain work will begin at the intersection of 10th Street and Central Avenue. A water shutdown is tentatively planned for 10:30 AM to 1:30 PM on 8/11 and any affected residents will be notified.

Starting Wednesday, watermain work will continue moving east along Central Avenue.

DETOUR INFO

The detour for Central Avenue will begin on 8/17 - this means Central Avenue will be CLOSED to eastbound traffic between Green Bay Road and Sheridan Road until the project shuts down for the winter.

TRAFFIC EXPECTATIONS

On Tuesday, 8/11:

- 10th Street between Central and Lake Avenues will be closed to local traffic only and blocked at Central Avenue.
- Traffic will be shifted to the south side of Central Avenue to accommodate watermain work. Two-way traffic will be maintained but there may be minor disruptions.

BUSINESS/RESIDENT NOTIFICATION

- Businesses and residents who will be affected by the watermain shutdown will be notified.
- IMPORTANT: If you have an irrigation system in your parkway please mark the location with flags or paint to help prevent damage by construction activities.
