**WORK COMPLETED THIS WEEK:
TUESDAY - FRIDAY [09.08 - 09.11]**

- New watermain installation continued downtown from 12th Street moving east past Wilmette Avenue
- Water service transfers between 9th and 8th Streets continue; those impacted will receive notice 24 hours prior to your service being transferred
- **School began Tuesday, September 8; please drive with care through the construction zone; we appreciate your patience and understanding!**

**WORK SCHEDULED NEXT WEEK:
MONDAY - FRIDAY [09.14 - 09.18]**

- Watermain crews will continue working downtown; work in the Central/Wilmette intersection is anticipated - *expect traffic delays and use alternate routes if possible*
- Watermain work at the intersections of 10th and 9th Streets scheduled for Monday will require a shutdown; those impacted will be notified
- Water service transfers will be completed between 9th and 8th Streets
- Watermain in the downtown area is set to be pressure tested and chlorinated in preparation for water service transfers
- Watermain work will begin east of 4th Street
- Temporary pavement between 10th and 8th Streets

DETOUR INFORMATION

Central Avenue is westbound-only from Sheridan Road through downtown to Green Bay Road. Traffic between 11th Street and Green Bay Road is now driving on the south side of Central Avenue. Angular parking is accessible for those traveling west. *Staging and detour information can be found at wilmettestreetscape.com/staging-detour-parking-maps/*

TRAFFIC EXPECTATIONS

- The Central/Wilmette intersection will be congested for watermain work
- Expect minor congestion and temporary lane shifts through the work zone
- Parking stalls on the south side of Central may be temporarily blocked near the work area as needed
- Downtown parking on Central now accommodates vehicles traveling west; parking on the north side of Central will be temporarily unavailable

BUSINESS/RESIDENT NOTIFICATION

- Residents/businesses requiring a water shutdown will be notified; residents between 9th and 8th should expect to see a notice soon
- Mark irrigation lines and contact us with any water service questions
