**WORK COMPLETED THIS WEEK:
MONDAY - FRIDAY [09.14 - 09.18]**

- Temporary pavement was installed between 10th and 8th Streets and in the downtown area
- Watermain work at Central intersections with Wilmette and 11th
- Watermain and hydrant work on Central from Wilmette to 11th
- Connection to existing main on the north leg of 8th Street
- Water services between 9th and 8th Streets
- Watermain installation between 3rd and 4th Streets continues east

**WORK SCHEDULED NEXT WEEK:
MONDAY - FRIDAY [09.21 - 09.25]**

- Watermain in the downtown area will be chlorinated and sampled in preparation for water services
- Watermain between 8th and 4th Streets will be chlorinated and sampled in preparation for water services
- Storm sewer work will begin downtown while waiting on chlorination results
- Watermain installation will continue moving east from 3rd Street
- **With increasing school traffic, please drive cautiously through construction zones and be mindful of construction activities**

DETOUR INFORMATION

Central Avenue is westbound-only from Sheridan Road through downtown to Green Bay Road. Traffic between 11th Street and Green Bay Road is now driving on the south side of Central Avenue. TRAFFIC EXPECTATIONS

- Central storm sewer work will cause congestion downtown including intersections with 11th, 12th and Wilmette
- Expect minor congestion and temporary lane shifts through the work zone
- Parking stalls on the south side of Central may be temporarily blocked near the work area as needed
- Downtown parking on Central now accommodates vehicles traveling west; parking on the north side of Central will be temporarily unavailable
