- Water service transfers in the 300 and 200 blocks
- General site cleanup in residential and downtown areas

- South side Central Avenue sidewalk removal and replacement is *tentative and weather dependent*; temporary access ramps to storefronts and a temporary pedestrian path will be provided
- Electrical work at the intersection of Central and Wilmette Avenues
- Water service transfers in the 300 and 200 blocks
- Watermain connections at 4th Street and Sheridan Road
- Temporary patching in residential areas

Central Avenue is westbound-only from Sheridan Road through downtown to Green Bay Road. Traffic between 11th Street and Green Bay Road is now driving on the north side of Central Avenue.
